We're improving the way we ask parents to pre-enroll for 2015-2016. In previous years, parents indicated their child's preferred school on a paper passport. In the spring of 2015, we're moving the process online. Between **March 23 and April 15, 2015**, parents of students currently attending district schools can select their child's preferred school for 2015-2016 on SchoolZone. You can even use the mobile version of SchoolZone to complete the process directly from your smartphone!

Information for parents about the 2015 Alberta Education Accountability Pillar Survey

As an annual check-up on the education system, the Accountability Pillar Survey provides an opportunity for Alberta Education and school authorities to ensure that we are equipping students for success.

The Accountability Pillar uses a set of 16 indicators consisting of surveys of students, parents and teachers on various aspects of quality, student outcomes such as dropout and high school completion rates; and provincial assessments of student learning.

From January to the end of February, Alberta Education will be conducting the annual Accountability Pillar Survey. In January, parents of students in grades 4, 7 and 10 will receive a survey from Alberta Education. In February, students in grades 4, 7 and all teachers will be completing their surveys online at school.

All surveys are anonymous and ask questions about experiences with the school. In addition to English and French, the parent survey is available in Chinese, Punjabi, Arabic, Blackfoot, Cree, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Urdu. Please contact Meadowlark Christian School, 780-483-6476, if you would like to receive the parent survey in a language other than English.

Your participation in the survey helps provide important information on the quality of education your child is receiving, so we encourage you to return your survey promptly.

Survey results will be available to school authorities in May 2015, and will be reported publicly as part of their 3-Year Education Plans and Annual Education Results Reports.


